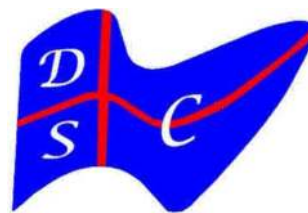

NOTICE OF RACE

2012 SABOT AUSTRALIA DAY REGATTA

1 RULES

The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing 2009-2012*, the prescriptions and special regulations of Yachting Australia, the rules and appendices of the Australian National Sabot Council, this Notice of Race and Yachting Australia Special Regulations Part 2 all as amended by the Sailing Instructions.

2. ADVERTISING

Boats and competitors may be required to display advertising as chosen by the organizing authority.

3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

3.1 The regatta is open to all Sabots that meet the requirements of the Australian National Sabot Council Constitution.

3.2 Eligible boats may enter by completing the online entry form at www.sailingresults.com.au

3.3 Racing will be in two divisions:

Junior division: Sailors must sail 2 up, and the age limit for both skipper and crew is up to and including the sailing season in which he/she has his/her 12th birthday.

Senior division: Sailors must sail 1 up (i.e. single handed), and the age limit is from the sailing seasons in which the skipper has his/her 13th birthday until the skipper has his/her 16th birthday, both seasons inclusive.

Sailors have the option of sailing in the senior or junior divisions during the two sailing seasons in which they have either their 11th or 12th birthday.

The "Sailing Season" shall be defined as 1 July 2011 to 30 June 2012.

3.4 Change of Crew

No change of crew will be permitted without prior written permission of the Race Committee.

5 FEES

Each boat shall pay a race fee of \$10.00 payable in cash only on the day of the race.

6 SCHEDULE

6.1 Briefing: 11:00

6.2 Race 1: Not before 12:00 – Subsequent races will follow as soon as practicable.

6.4 No Warning Signal shall be made after 16:00.

6.5 The presentation will be held after the conclusion of racing.

7 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be available no less than one week before the first race at www.drummoynesailingclub.com.au.

8 VENUE

The venue shall be the Drummoyne Sailing Club, 2 St Georges Crescent, Drummoyne.

9 THE COURSES

The courses to be sailed will be as described in the sailing instructions.

10 SCORING

10.1 The Low Point System of Appendix A will apply.

10.2 The regatta will consist of up to 3 races. 1 race is required to be completed to complete a series.

10.3 When fewer than 3 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

11 RADIO COMMUNICATION

Except in an emergency, a boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats.

12 PRIZES

Prizes will be given as described in the sailing instructions.

13 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

14 INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of \$10,000,000.
